




- The Malcolm X & Dr. Betty Shabazz Memorial & Educational Center Site of Malcolm X's assassination.
- **1** <u>409 Edgecombe Ave.</u> Home of cultural & political leaders, including Julius Bledsoe, W.E.B. Du Bois, & Thurgood Marshall.
- 1 935 St. Nicholas Ave. The Edward Kennedy "Duke" Ellington House.
- Trinity Cemetery at the Chapel of the Intercession (John James Audubon's former estate) Only remaining active cemetery in Manhattan. Non-denominational. Center of the Heritage Rose District.
- Audubon Terrace Beaux Arts complex: Hispanic Society of America, American Academy of Arts & Letters, Boricua College, Church of Our Lady of Esperanza.
- **1** John T. Brush Stairway presented by the NY Giants in 1913 remnant of the old Polo Grounds sports stadium.
- © Coogan's Bluff (East of Edgecombe above 155th) Promontory named for James J. Coogan (1845-1915), Manhattan Borough President in 1898.
- **10** <u>Jehovah's Witnesses Assembly</u> formerly Hebrew Tabernacle (now on 184th & Ft. Wash, which was formerly Fourth Church of Christ, Scientist)
- National Track & Field Hall of Fame (former Fort Washington Ave. Armory)
